the Board of Education unanimously approved the following
Resolution:*

Section 1 - Date/Place/Time/Purpose of Vote:The Annual District Election and Budget Vote of the Deer Park Union Free School District will be held on Tuesday, May 16, 2017 at the Deer Park High School **gymnasium**, 1 Falcon Place, Deer Park. Said Annual District Election and Budget Vote as set forth in the Notice of said Annual District Election, annexed hereto, shall be held for the purposes of : (1) voting upon the annual School District Budget and Tax Levy for the school year 2017-2018; (2) electing two members of the Board of Education; two for a term of three years for the seats of Alfred Centamore and Donna Gulli Grunseich, beginning July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2020; (3) voting upon the Capital Funds Proposition and (4) transacting such other business as may properly come before the voters. The polls will remain open from 7:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. and as much longer as may be necessary to enable the voters then present to cast their ballots.

Section 2 – Public Hearing: A public hearing on the proposed budget of the School District will be held on May 9, 2017, at the Administration Office, 1881 Deer Park Avenue at 7:30 P.M.

Section 3 – Legal Notice: The Legal Notice of the Annual District Election and Budget Vote provided for in Appendix A is deemed a part of this Resolution, including each proposition to be presented to the qualified registered voters of the School District required by law to be contained in such Notice, and is hereby approved.

Section 4 – Publication of Legal Notice: The District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice to be given of said Annual District Election and Budget Vote in the form prescribed above, by publishing the Notice four times within the seven weeks next preceding such Annual District Election, the first publication to be at least forty-five days prior to the said Annual District Election, in the Beacon and Long Island Business News, two newspapers having general circulation in said School District, and by giving such other notice as, in her discretion, may be deemed desirable.

Section 5 – Designation of Permanent Chairperson and Acting Clerk: The District Clerk, Lisa Brennan is hereby appointed to serve as permanent chairperson of the Annual Election and Budget vote; and Concetta Bertelle is hereby appointed as acting clerk to serve in absence or inability of the District Clerk to act on the day of the vote.

Section 6 – Appointment of Election Inspectors: The following qualified voters of said School District are hereby appointed as the election inspectors for the Annual District Election and Budget Vote:

Section 7 – Appointment of Board of Registration: The following four duly qualified voters of said School District are hereby appointed as members of the Board of Registration of said School District until 30 days following the Annual Election and Budget Vote:

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Section 8 – Authority to Hire Substitutes: In the event that any of the above election inspectors or Board of Registration members is unable to serve, the District Clerk is authorized to hire substitutes as needed.

Section 9 – Compensation of Election Workers: Each election inspector and Board of Registration member shall be entitled to compensation at the rate of \$12.00/hr. The District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to give written notice of appointment to the persons herein respectively appointed as election inspectors and registrars said Annual District Meeting.

Section 10 – Rental of Voting Machines: The District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to rent the necessary voting machines and to have the necessary voting machine labels printed for said voting machines in the form corresponding as nearly as may be with the requirements of the Education Law, and the voting rules of the School District.

Section 11 – Casting and Canvassing of “Affidavit Envelope Ballots”: The District Clerk and such Members of the Board of Registration as shall be then present in the polling place are hereby designated as a set of poll clerks to cast and canvass any “affidavit ballots” received in accordance with §2019-a of the Education Law, as soon as may be practicable after the closing of the polls. The District Clerk shall notify each candidate by first class mail at least five days prior to the vote that said ballots will be cast and canvassed in accordance with the statute at such time and place. Each such candidate shall be entitled to have one person to attend such casting and canvassing.

Section 12 – Acceptance of Voting Results: A Special Meeting of the Board of Education shall be held on Tuesday, May 16, 2017, in the gymnasium of the Deer Park High School following the closing of the polls for the purpose of accepting and declaring the results of the voting on all matters submitted to the qualified voters at said Annual District Election and Budget Vote.

Section 13 – Effective Date: This resolution shall take effect immediately.

(Security Guards)

Upon a motion by Ms. Gulli Grunseich, seconded by Mr. Rooney, the Board of Education unanimously approved the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, The CSEA, Inc., Local 1000, AFSCME, AFLCIO, Deer Park Unit (hereinafter "CSEA") is the exclusive representative of all Non-teaching employees of Deer Park Union Free School District, Town of Babylon excluding the Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds, School Lunch Director, School Physician, Transportation Supervisor, Security Personnel, School Attorney, Aides and Substitute Bus Drivers.

WHEREAS, CSEA and the District are parties to a collective bargaining agreement (hereinafter "CBA"), expiring June 30, 2017.

WHEREAS, CSEA, requested that the Deer Park Union Free School District recognize the CSEA to be the Bargaining Unit Representatives for the employees holding the position of Guard for the purpose of collective bargaining;

WHEREAS, CSEA has filed a Unit Clarification/Unit Placement Petition with the New York Public Employment Relations Board (hereinafter "PERB") seeking to add the position of Guard to the existing CSEA bargaining unit; and

WHEREAS, in order to avoid the time and expense of further litigation of this matter and in furtherance of good labor relations, the parties seek to resolve this matter.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions set forth herein, the parties mutually agree as follows:

1. Effective upon full execution of this agreement, the District shall continue to recognize CSEA as the exclusive representative for all existing titles in the above referenced unit along with the newly recognized title of Guard, for the purposes of collective bargaining and the administration of grievances.
2. There shall be no changes in terms and conditions of employment for any of the employees in the title of Guard being accreted into the unit. Their current terms and conditions of employment shall remain in effect until such time as different terms and conditions of employment, if any, are negotiated to completion by and between CSEA and the District.
3. The existing terms of the CBA shall remain in full force and effect under law for those employees that were in the bargaining unit prior to the accretion of the Guard title to the bargaining unit, until such time as different terms and conditions of employment, if any, are negotiated to completion by and between CSEA and the District.
4. CSEA, upon signature and approval of this MOA by the District shall withdraw the current Unit Placement-/Unit Clarification Petition (CP-1511) pending before PERB, in its entirety.
5. This memorandum shall be subject to approval by the Board of Education.
